

**AN ORDINANCE REDIVIDING THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS
FOR ELECTION PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois (the “City”) is a home-rule unit of local government under Article VII, Section 6, of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and, except as limited by such Section, it may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the decennial census was taken in 2022, which resulted in population gains and changes within the City’s boundaries; and

WHEREAS, these population changes require the City to consider and review potential shifts in its ward boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Cook County, Illinois has determined that, in order to comply with Section 5-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/5-2-4), the district boundary lines of the wards of the City should be adjusted so that the population of each of the City’s seven wards is as nearly equal as practicable, and so that each such ward is of as compact and contiguous territory as practicable.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois:

SECTION 1: The foregoing recital clauses to this Ordinance are adopted as the findings of the corporate authorities of the City of Rolling Meadows and are incorporated herein by specific reference.

SECTION 2: The City of Rolling Meadows is, for purposes of conducting municipal elections and for such other purposes as are, or may be, provided by law, divided into seven wards, as described on Exhibit “A”, attached hereto and made a part hereof, and as illustrated on Exhibit “B”, attached hereto and made a part hereof. Each of the seven wards shall be represented by one alderman who shall be elected by only the electors of that district.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 4: If any provisions or portion of this Ordinance or its application to any person, entity or property is held invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect the application or validity or enforceability of any other provisions or portions of this Ordinance; and, to that end, all provisions and portions of this

Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 5: If any section, paragraph or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6: The manner of conducting, voting at, and contesting elections for the City of Rolling Meadows shall be in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois relating to elections in cities having a managerial form of municipal government.

SECTION 7: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

SECTION 8: This Ordinance shall be printed and published in pamphlet form by order of the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows.


SECTION 9: A certified copy of this Ordinance shall be transmitted to the Illinois State Board of Elections and to the Cook County Clerk.





EXHIBIT "A"

DESCRIPTION OF ROLLING MEADOWS WARD BOUNDARIES

WARD ONE

Commencing at the northwest corner of lot 15 of Wexford Unit 2 Subdivision, then west, north, south and east along the municipal boundaries to the center line of Meacham Road then north along the center line of Meacham Road to where it intersects with the existing municipal boundaries and then north, west, south and east following the municipal limits to a point on the east right-of-way line of Meacham Road and Plum Grove Road across from the north line of lot 3 of Herman Kreft's Woodlands Subdivision and then north along the east right-of-way line of Meacham Road and Plum Grove Road to the point where Lincoln Avenue would intersect with the east right-of-way line of Plum Grove Road then west to the municipal limits and then south, east and west along the municipal limits to the point of beginning.

WARD TWO

Commencing at a point at the northeast corner of Euclid Avenue and Rohlwing Road rights-of-way, then north, east, west and south along the municipal boundaries to a point on the west right-of-way of Plum Grove Road then south along the west right-of-way line of Plum Grove Road to a point where Lincoln Avenue would intersect with the west right-of-way line of Plum Grove Road then east to the east right-of-way line of Plum Grove Road then south along the east right-of-way line of Plum Grove Road to a point where Old Plum Grove Road would intersect with the east right-of-way line of Plum Grove Road and then east, south, west and north along the municipal boundaries to the west property line of Brookwood Condominiums then south and east along the limits of the Brookwood Condominiums to a point on the east right-of-way line of West Frontage Road then south to a point even with the center line of Kingfisher Lane then east across Illinois Route 53 and following the center line of Kingfisher Lane to the center line of Salt Creek, then north along the center line of Salt Creek to the center line of Kirchoff Road, then west along the center line of Kirchoff Road to the center line of Rohlwing Road and then north on the center line of Rohlwing Road to the point of beginning.

WARD THREE

Commencing at a point in the center of the intersection of Kirchoff Road and Wilke Road and then north along the center line of Wilke Road to the north right-of-way line of the Euclid Avenue, then west along the north right-of-way line to the center line of Rohlwing Road, then south along the center line of Rohlwing Road to the center line of Kirchoff Road and then east and south along the center line of Kirchoff Road to the point of beginning.

WARD FOUR

Commencing at a point in the center of the intersection of Kirchoff Road and Wilke Road then south along Wilke Road and New Wilke Road following municipal boundaries to a point in the center of Central Road, then west along the center line of Central Road to Salt Creek, then north along the center line of Salt Creek to the center line of Kirchoff Road, then east along the center line of Kirchoff Road to the point of beginning.

WARD FIVE

Commencing at a point in the middle of the intersection of Central Road and Weber Drive and then south to the north right-of-way line of Illinois Route 62 and then west along the north right-of-way line of Illinois Route 62 to the center line of Kimball Hill Drive and then north along the center line of Kimball Hill Drive to the intersection with South Hampton Drive/Calvert Drive and then north along the center line of Calvert Drive to the center line of North Hampton Drive and west along the center line of North Hampton Drive to its western terminus and then north along the west line of Williamsburg Subdivision to the south property line of Rolling Meadows High School and then west along the south property line of Rolling Meadows High School to the center line of Barker Avenue and then north along the center line of Barker Avenue to the center line of Central Road and then east along the center line of Central Road to the point of the beginning.

WARD SIX

Commencing at a point in the center of the intersection of Central Road and Brookmeade Drive and then south along the center line of Brookmeade Drive to the center line of Magnolia Drive then south along the center line of Magnolia Drive and extending to the south right-of-way of Illinois Route 62 then west to the west right-of-way line of Illinois Route 53, then south along the west right-of-way of Illinois Route 53 to the south right-of-way line of Illinois Route 58, then east along the south right-of-way line of Illinois Route 58 to the north right-of-way line of the Northwest Tollway (I-90) then southeast and northeast along municipal boundaries to the south right-of-way line of Illinois Route 62 then west along the south right-of-way line of Illinois Route 62 to the center line of New Wilke Road, then north to the north right-of-way line of Illinois Route 62, then west along the north right-of-way line of Illinois Route 62 to the center line of Kimball Hill Drive then north along the center line of Kimball Hill Drive to the intersection of South Hampton Drive/Calvert Drive then north along the center line of Calvert Drive to the center line of North Hampton Drive and west along the center line of North Hampton Drive to its western terminus and then north along the west line of Williamsburg Subdivision to the south property line of Rolling Meadows High School and then west along the south property line of Rolling Meadows High School to the center line of Barker Avenue and then north along the center line of Barker Avenue to the center line of Central Road and then west along the center line of Central Road to the point of the beginning.

WARD SEVEN


Commencing at a point in the center of the intersection of Central Road and Salt Creek, then north along the center line of Salt Creek to a point where the north line of Lot 1832 of Rolling Meadows Unit 11 extended would intersect and then west from said point along the north line of Lot 1832 and continuing west along the center line of Kingfisher Lane to the west right-of-way line of West Frontage Road and then north along the west right-of-way line to a point where the south property line of Brookwood Condominiums extended would intersect and then west along the line to the west property line of Brookwood Condominiums then south, west and north following municipal boundaries to the center line of Meacham Road then south along the center line of Meacham Road to where it intersects with the existing municipal boundaries and then follows to the east, north, south and west along the municipal boundary to a point on the north right-of-way line of Illinois Route 62 and then west along the north right-of-way line to a point even with the Arbor Drive west right-of-way line, then south, west, east and north on Arbor Drive following the municipal limits to the south right-of-way line of Illinois Route 62, then east along the south right-of-way of Illinois Route 62 to the center line of Magnolia Drive then north along the center line of Magnolia Drive to the center line of Brookmeade Drive then north along the center line of Brookmeade Drive to the center line of Central Road, then east on the center line of Central Road to the point of beginning.




EXHIBIT B **SEPT. 2, 2022**
