

RESOLUTION NO. 23-R-42

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT TO PRE-FORM TRAFFIC CONTROL SYSTEMS FOR ANNUAL PAVEMENT PAINT STRIPING SERVICES IN A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$55,000

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows (“City”) Public Works Department is responsible for maintenance of roadways within City limits; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rolling Meadows is a home-rule community, and the City Council may waive formal bidding procedures if it determines that such action is in the best interest of its residents; and

WHEREAS, roadway striping is a common and beneficial method of roadway maintenance increasing visibility of paint lines for traffic safety; and

WHEREAS, Pre-Form Traffic Control Systems submitted a quote for roadway striping; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director is recommending that the City’s past practice of utilizing Pre-Form Traffic Control Systems for pavement traffic control liquid paint striping be continued because of the quality of the product they offer, and other benefits associated with standardization and vendor familiarity; and

WHEREAS, the 2023 FY Budget (61.70.5010.54640) provides funding for street lane markings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS, ILLINOIS, as follows;

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as though set forth in this Section 1.

Section 2. Approval. The Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the agreements and other necessary documents with Pre-form Traffic Control Systems for the services of road striping in a not to exceed the amount of \$55,000.

Section 3. Waiver of Competitive Bidding. To the extent any competitive bidding requirements apply to the agreements with Pre-form Traffic Control Systems, such competitive bidding requirements are hereby waived pursuant to section 8-9-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-9-1).


Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its approval in the manner provided by law.
