

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY CODE IN ORDER  
TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF CLASS A-2 LIQUOR LICENSES  
ISSUED IN THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS  
(Los 2 Pollos Restaurant)**

**Whereas**, paragraph (a) of Sec. 6-37 entitled "Restriction on Number and Classification," of Article II entitled "Licenses," of Chapter 6 entitled "Alcoholic Beverages," of the City Code of Rolling Meadows sets forth the total number and classification of liquor licenses to be issued by the City; and

**Whereas**, the establishment Los 2 Pollos Restaurant has requested and applied for the issuance of a Class A-2 liquor license; and

**Whereas**, the City Council finds it necessary and in the best interest of the City of Rolling Meadows to amend paragraph (a) of Sec. 6-37 entitled "Restriction on Number and Classification," of Article II entitled "Licenses," of Chapter 6 entitled "Alcoholic Beverages," of the City Code to increase the number of Class A-2 liquor licenses by one, in order to allow for the issuance of said liquor license to Los 2 Pollos Restaurant.

**Now Therefore, Be It Ordained** by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois, as follows:

**Section One:** Paragraph (a) of Sec. 6-37 entitled "Restriction on Number and Classification," of Article II entitled "Licenses," of Chapter 6 entitled "Alcoholic Beverages," of the City Code of Rolling Meadows is amended, in part, by revising the following subparagraph to read as follows:

(2) Eighteen Class A-2 licenses.

**Section Two:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.


**Section Three:** This Ordinance shall be printed and published in pamphlet form by order of the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows.
