

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS**

WHEREAS, B & P Apparatus, Inc. is in the business of selling fire department vehicles and the City has utilized this companies services in the past. The commission for B & P Apparatus, Inc. is 10% of the sale price; and

WHEREAS, in the opinion of a majority of the Corporate Authorities of the City of Rolling Meadows, it is no longer necessary, useful, or in the best interest of the City to retain ownership of the personal property hereinafter described.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

**SECTION ONE:** Pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the City Council finds that the following described personal property now owned by the City of Rolling Meadows is no longer necessary or useful or in the best interest of the City to maintain and the City would be best served by the property's sale:

**SECTION TWO:** The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Listing Agreement with B & P Apparatus, Inc. on behalf of the City.

**SECTION THREE:** No offer shall be accepted for the sale of the property which is less than the minimum value of \$14,000.00, unless the City Manager or her designee so authorizes.

**SECTION FOUR:** Upon payment in full of the purchase price for the above personal property, the City Manager is authorized to convey and transfer the title and ownership of said personal property to the Purchaser.

**SECTION FIVE:** In the event the above property is not sold within six (6) months of the date of the Listing Agreement, the City Manager is further authorized and directed to dispose of the property by private sale or auction at such price to be determined by the City Manager.






