

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 106 “TRAFFIC”**

**Whereas**, the City currently restricts parking along portions of Arbor Drive; and

**Whereas**, the owner of the 12 Oaks at Woodfield complex has requested that the City provide for 46 parking spaces along portion of the south and east portions of Arbor Drive; and

**Whereas**, the City agrees to provide 46 parking spaces provided that the parking is by permit to be issued by the owner of the property commonly known as 12 Oaks at Woodfield to residents of the complex.

**Now Therefore**, Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois, as follows:

**Section One:** Chapter 106 “Traffic” of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended at Section 106-18 by substituting the following for the first reference to restricted parking along Arbor Drive:

<b>Street</b>	<b>Limits</b>
Arbor Drive	That part of Arbor Drive parallel to Algonquin Road which is also known as Frontage Road along both sides as one proceeds in a more or less clockwise direction around the property commonly known as 12 Oaks at Woodfield, except that portion of Arbor Drive located along the north side of the southern portion of Arbor Drive and the west side of the east portion of Arbor Drive which collectively provides for 46 parking spaces as striped by the Director of Public Works

**Section Two:** Chapter 106 “Traffic” is hereby amended by adding thereto, the following:

106-26.1 Arbor Drive Permit Parking

Permit Parking only shall be permitted on Arbor Drive. The penalty for a violation of this section should be the same as the

penalty for parking violations as set forth in Appendix B in the Code of Ordinances.

**Section Three:** Chapter 106 "Traffic" Section 106-19 is hereby amended as follows:

**Sec. 106-19. Parking during snow removal.**

It is unlawful to park any vehicle for a period of time longer than three minutes for loading and unloading of passengers or 30 minutes for loading and unloading of property in any place, whether designated as a loading zone or not so designated, at any time after snow begins to fall and for a period of eight hours after snow stops falling, if the snow on the street exceeds one inch in depth (two inches in depth on Arbor Drive), provided that the eight-hour parking restriction shall continue during snow removal operations until completed.

**Section Four:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage and approval as required by law.


**Section Five:** This Ordinance shall be printed and published in pamphlet form by order of the City Council of Rolling Meadows, Illinois.
