To become a Rolling Meadows Police Officer You must meet the following minimum requirements:

- US Citizen or Legal Alien
- Valid driver's license
- 21 years of age or less than 35 at time of appointment, or exempt by statute.
- Vision correctable to 20/40 and free of color blindness
- High school diploma or its equivalent
- Completion of 60 credit hours from an accredited college or university.
- Must pass P.O.W.E.R. Test before entry to police academy.
- Pass all requirements set forth by the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners.

Upon a conditional offer of employment pass a physical examination and drug screening.
