WHAT IS THE PREMISE ALERT PROGRAM?

The Premise Alert Program consists of a database of special needs citizens living, working, or attending educational facilities in the City of Rolling Meadows who voluntarily supply the following information; the member's name, date of birth, address, phone numbers, emergency notifications (family, friends, or clergy), medical alert information, and pets in the home.

Voluntary members will be required to complete an application form that will be updated every two years or when such information changes.

Citizens electing to participate in the Premise Alert Program, providing special needs information will not be subject to any preferential treatment over any other citizen



HOW DOES THE PROGRAM HELP YOU?

The Premise Alert Program was developed to ensure that consistently high levels of public safety services are available to all members of the State, including people who may require special consideration in order to access services. The ability to identify special needs individuals, their places of employment, educational facilities, and residences are valuable resources in instances when or if an emergency response by law enforcement or the fire department are needed. When law enforcement or fire protection personnel are dispatched to a location in Rolling Meadows, the dispatcher will relay any information about a special needs situation at that location.



HOW DOES THE PROGRAM HELP YOU?

The Rolling Meadows Police Department has always made it a priority to protect the privacy of the public we serve. Everyone associated with our organization is committed to maintaining your privacy. New government regulations have been outlined in the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA). These regulations provide an additional way to help guarantee privacy. Privacy remains a top priority for the department.

As an organization dedicated to safeguarding persons' medical records, the Rolling Meadows Police Department has prepared a Privacy Notice. This notice details how health information will be used and disclosed.
