Parking Survey

On or about December 1, 2013 the Cook County Court House in Rolling Meadows will begin charging a fee for parking in the garage at 2121 Euclid Avenue. The Rolling Meadows Police Department expects that those using the Court Facility may choose to avoid paying the daily parking fee and will seek alternate parking. The city streets that we expect to be affected are St. James Street from Wilke to Wren, Wren to Fremont and Fremont West to Jay Lane. Also affected will be Dove Street North to Campbell and potentially Eastman and Wing Streets west from Dove Street.

The Rolling Meadows Police Department is seeking feedback from residents as to parking restriction solutions for your neighborhood. Those options are:

- Post "No Parking on both sides of the street between 7 a.m. and 4 p.m. on week days only" signs.
- Maintain the current parking restrictions and allow parking on one side of the street.
- Post "Permit Parking Only" signs on the side streets and issue fee based permits to non-residents, and no fee based permits to residents, or resident's guests.
- Install daily fee based parking devices on each corner, in essence allow parking, but charge a daily parking fee.
