

Recycling and COVID-19 Concerns

Q: What if I or someone in my household show COVID-19 symptoms?

A: Do NOT recycle. Bag all recyclables and place them in your trash/refuse cart.

Q: When can I resume normal recycling if I have had COVID-19 symptoms?

A: Resume normal recycling when no one in your household shows signs or symptoms of COVID-19.

Q: Can I still recycle if I don't have signs of COVID-19?

A: Yes. Continue to place empty, clean & loose recyclables in your recycle cart.

Bag and Trash These Items



Bag & Tie Your Garbage



Garbage crews ask that residents and businesses place all trash in bags, and seal those bags, before setting them at the curb for collection.

Unclosed or Damaged Bags Will NOT be Picked up



To keep our garbage crews safe during COVID-19, open, untied, or damaged bags will NOT be picked up.

Tips on how to help if you have issues with critters:

- Place garbage at curb in morning by 6:00 AM
- Double Bag Smelly Waste
- Spray bags with Windex/Ammonia

Please re-bag damaged garbage that is not picked up and save for next pickup.
