First day petitions may be circulated by independent candidates and newly formed political parties.

MONDAY, DECEMBER 12, 2022

PETITION FILING BEGINS AT 8:00 AM IN THE CITY CLERK'S OFFICE, 3600 Kirchoff Road, Rolling Meadow, IL 60008. If there should be more than one person in line at 8:00 AM, a lottery will be held following the close of filing to determine candidate placement on the ballot. **PETITION FILING CLOSES AT 5:00 PM ON MONDAY, DECEMBER 19, 2022.** If there should be more than one person to file between the hours of 4:00 PM and 5:00 PM on that date, a lottery will be held to determine the final place on the ballot.

Positions to be elected:

MAYOR – 4-YEAR TERM
CITY CLERK – 4-YEAR TERM
ALDERMAN WARD 1 – 4-YEAR TERM
ALDERMAN WARD 3 – 4-YEAR TERM
ALDERMAN WARD 5 – 4-YEAR TERM
ALDERMAN WARD 7 – 4-YEAR TERM

Questions regarding the Municipal Election should be directed to the State Board of Elections. Municipal Elections are administered by the County Clerks. It is the responsibility of the CANDIDATE or the representative of the candidate to ensure that all documents presented are in good order and compliant with all appropriate election law. Neither the Clerk's office nor the City of Rolling Meadows is responsible for the accuracy or legal sufficiency of the filed documents. Please remember that a 2022 Statement of Economic Interest must be filed with the COOK County Clerk by the close of business on December 19, 2022.
