

**NOTICE OF PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX LEVY FOR
CITY OF ROLLING MEADOWS, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

I. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax levy increase for the City of Rolling Meadows, Illinois (the “taxing district”) for Tax Levy Year 2025 will be held on Tuesday, November 10, 2025 at 7:00 p.m. To attend in person, go to the City of Rolling Meadows’ City Hall, 3600 Kirchoff Road, Rolling Meadows, Illinois 60008. (Includes both the City and Library tax levies.)

II. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended or abated for 2024 were \$19,624,500.

The proposed corporate and special purpose property taxes to be levied for 2025 are \$19,806,311. This represents a 0.9% increase over the previous year.

III. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for 2024 were \$314,980.

The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service and public building commission leases for 2025 are \$312,974. This represents a 0.6% decrease from the previous year.

IV. The total property taxes extended or abated for 2024 were \$19,939,480. The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2025 are \$20,119,305. This represents a 0.9% increase over the previous year.

The City of Rolling Meadows is beginning the process of issuing bonds to help pay for local road improvements. In the first year, the cost is estimated at about \$512,000. To reduce the impact on residents, the City plans to cover half of that amount directly, so the full cost will not be added to property taxes.

The City's goal is to keep the overall property tax increase at 2.0%. For a Rolling Meadows property with an assessed value of \$300,000, the estimated increase—including road improvement funding—will be approximately \$28 for the year. The Library levy adds to the overall property tax increase by an additional \$11 per year for the average property tax bill within the City of Rolling Meadows.
